In February a Welcoming Day of Observance important to LGBTQ+/TGNB communities that brings visibility and affirmation after invisibility and erasure is National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day (NBHAAD) on the first Wednesday of February. This is a national HIV testing and treatment community mobilization initiative targeted at Blacks in the United States and the Diaspora.

Many Federal agencies have developed public awareness and education campaigns to address HIV prevention, treatment, care and research.
